General Policies and Procedures & Requirements for Application

The Knights of Columbus Council 16103 will award TEN \$750.00 non-renewable Grants to students graduating **high school** in the Spring of 2022 (Class of 2022) and attending a college, university, trade or craft school in the Fall of 2022. Students are eligible if they are **either:**

- A **Brother Knight** or immediate family member of a **Brother Knight** who is a member in good standing of Knights of Columbus St. Faustina Council 16103. **Both children, grandchildren, & survivors of deceased Brother Knights qualify as immediate family.**
- **OR** a member of a **registered family** at St. Faustina Catholic Church in Fulshear, TX.

The applicant must, prior to the award of the Grant:

1. Be accepted & enrolled as a Full-Time student for the Fall 2022 at a College, University, Trade, or Craft School, and provide proof thereof.
2. The applicant must attach latest copy (last completed semester) of a high school **transcript** (whichever is appropriate). Transcripts can be copies.
3. The Applicant must provide **one (1) Letter of Recommendation** (from a non-relative over eighteen years) with the application.

DEADLINE - 5:00pm on Monday, April 4, 2022

One original and one copy of the completed application (including copies of the transcripts and reference letters) must be received by **5:00pm on Monday, April 4, 2022**. The deadline is strictly observed.

HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS

1. In the January, applications are made available through the Knights of Columbus Council 16103 website, the Knights of Columbus page on St. Faustina's website, & the parish office at St. Faustina's Catholic Church. Complete page 1 & Answer all 5 Questions – for Questions 4 & 5 limit answers to one page maximum.

2. Completed applications are due in the Parish Office ***by mail or in person*** by **5:00pm on Monday, April 4, 2022**. The deadline is strictly observed.

3. A Grant Committee, consisting of Brother Knights appointed by the Grand Knight of Council 16103, will review all applications and the Chairman will make the decisions of the committee known to all applicants by May 16, 2022. The Grants will be awarded at either the Graduation Mass or the July, 2022 Business Meeting of Council 16103.

Selection Process

The Grand Knight will assign a Chairman of the Grant Committee who will review each application as it is received to ensure that the application has been properly completed. The chairman will confirm whether or not the applicant is an immediate family member of a Brother Knight who is a member in good standing of Knights of Columbus Council 16103 or a member of a registered family at St. Faustina Church in Fulshear, TX.

When the application is considered complete, and the applicant deemed qualified, a copy of the original is made but the applicant's name, as well as all references to his/her name will be removed and replaced with a code number. The chairman will keep a master list so that codes can be matched with names once a recipient is chosen.

**The Committee will reserve five (5) college grants for applicants who are Knights in Good Standing of the Council or immediate family member thereof.* [If less than 5 applicants qualify in this category then applicants who are members of a registered parish family will be considered for the remaining scholarships that were reserved. Also, if more than 5 applicants qualify for the reserved grants then those applicants not awarded a reserve grant will be considered for the remaining five grants along with the applicants who are a member of a registered family of St. Faustina Catholic Church but not family of a Knight.]*

Once the Committee selects its recipients, the Chairman identifies them to the Grand Knight. The recipients of the Grants are then notified by a letter, which describes the procedure for awarding the Grant.
